Grinder Pump and STEP System Usage and Maintenance

Maintenance of Grinder Pumps within the PCRSD system is the responsibility of the property owner.

Misuse of the systems referenced above is discouraged. Misuse includes, but is not limited to, flushing or dumping items into the sanitary sewer that are not liquid or that are not easily broken down/dissolved.

Sanitary sewage collection lines are meant to carry human waste and wastewater generated by humans to a centralized facility for treatment before release back into the ecosystem. Food items disposed of through a garbage disposal are acceptable in the system but not advised. Any other items placed in the system are considered misuse of the system.

Service calls and/or repair costs for damage or failure of a pump because of misuse of the system is the responsibility of the property owner.

Listed (but not limited to) are common items that should NOT be placed in ANY sanitary sewer system:

- Diapers
- Feminine Hygiene products
- Birth Control Products
- GREASE
- Toys
- Granular Detergent
- Unused or outdated pharmaceuticals
- Wood products
- Paint products
